We take User privacy seriously and takes reasonable efforts to protect it. We have created this Privacy Policy (hereafter “Policy”) in order to share with you our information collection and use practices. **AS MORE CLEARLY DEFINED HEREIN, WE WILL NEVER KNOWINGLY SELL OR ASSIGN YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION WITHOUT YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND/OR APPROVAL.** Please read this Policy carefully before sharing any personally identifiable information described below.

What personally identifiable information does MotivEat collect and how is it used?

When you visit, register or order products or services on <http://www.motiveat.co.uk> you may be asked to provide certain information about yourself including your name, email address, home or business address and other information. MotivEat will not collect personally identifiable information from Users while they use the web site, unless they voluntarily provide it to us or authorize us to collect such information. Users may provide other information about themselves, in addition to the mandatory Personal Information (hereafter “Voluntary Information”).

MotivEat may use or disclose User’s personally identifiable information to:

1. Operate and manage the Company web site;
2. Provide products/services that have been requested by User;
3. Respond to other inquires or requests by User.
4. To anyone authorised In Law to request It.

In order to provide the best services to User, MotivEat may disclose User name on certain pages at <http://motiveat.co.uk>. We may also disclose personally identifiable information in the establishment or exercise of legal rights or defences against legal claims, to comply with applicable laws or regulations, to comply with a valid legal process, such as a search warrant, subpoena or court order or to investigate suspected fraud or a violation of our Terms and Conditions of Use. We will never sell User information to any 3rd-party not affiliated with MotivEat, without consent, except in connection with the sale or merger of MotivEat or the division responsible for such services provided.

MotivEat may also use such Voluntary Information for marketing its products and services to User unless User has 'opted out' of receiving such marketing Information from us. User may 'opt out' by contacting Customer Service at info@motiveat.co.uk.

MotivEat may, from time to time, send or post surveys or requests for User Feedback in order to help us make our web site and services better. Any responses we receive from Users will be used only to evaluate our web site and services and no personally identifiable information from respondents will be shared with any Non-employees of Company, except that information provided in the Feedback/Comments areas.

To maintain customer service standards and to assist staff training, we may record and monitor incoming calls.

What non-personally identifiable information does company collect and how is it used?
